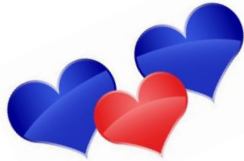
Data Submission & QA Reports

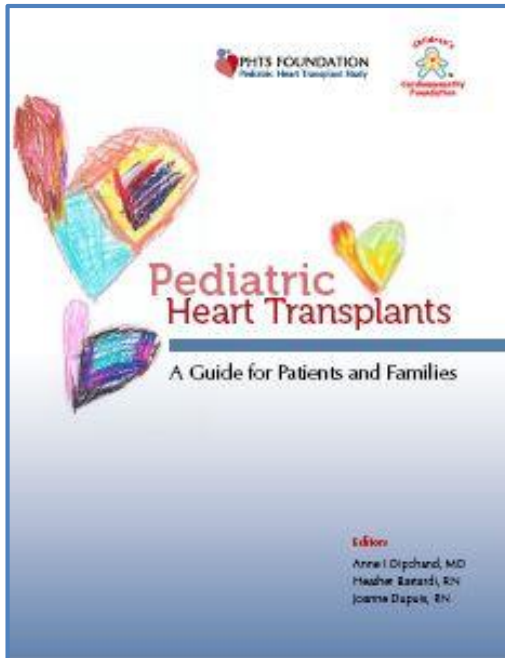

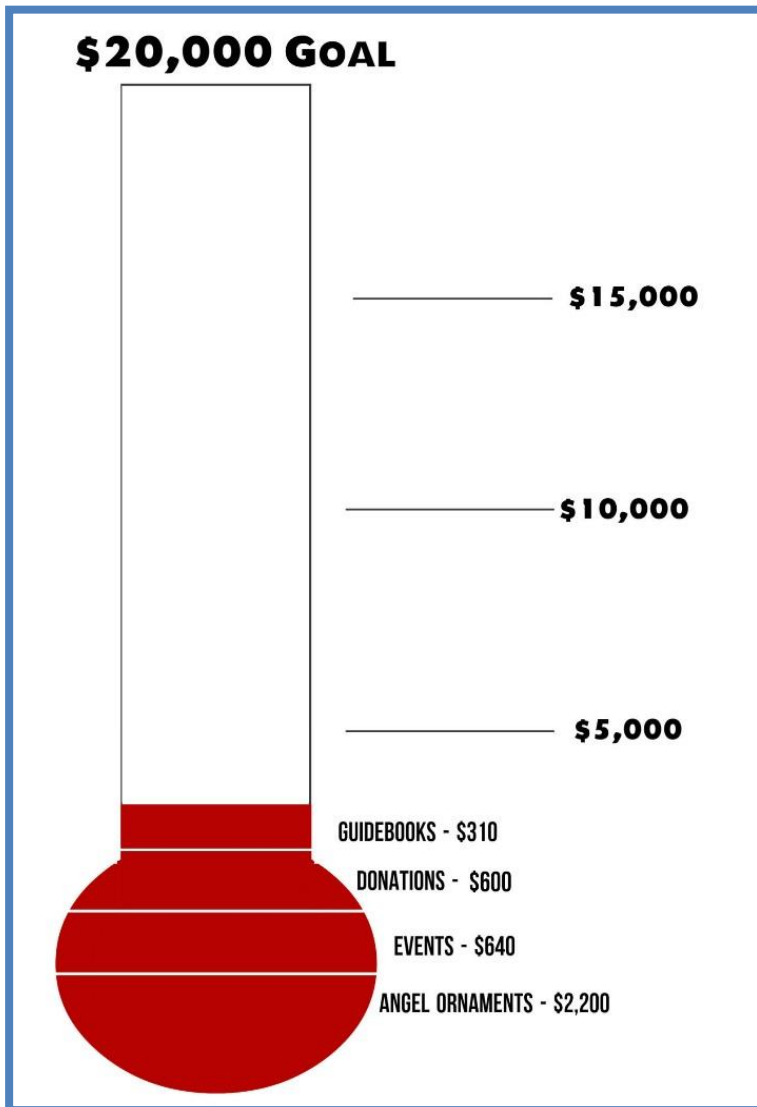
